RESTRICTIONS TO CURBSIDE PARKING

Eastern Parkway (Service Road) between Grand Army Plaza and Washington Avenue

Beginning On/About Monday, August 22, 2011

Installations of combined sewers and trunk water mains
Monday – Friday between the hours of 7:00AM–6:00PM

Beginning on/about Monday, August 22, 2011, and, continuing for approximately six (6) months, the NYC Department of Design and Construction (DDC) will eliminate and/or restrict curbside parking along the Eastern Parkway Service Road between Grand Army Plaza and Washington Avenue.

PLEASE NOTE:

DURING WORK HOURS:

- Motorists will be unable to enter the Eastern Parkway Service Road at Washington Avenue.
 - To access the Eastern Parkway Service Road, motorists will have to make a left turn at Underhill Avenue.
 - Flag-persons will be strategically placed to maintain a smooth flow of traffic.

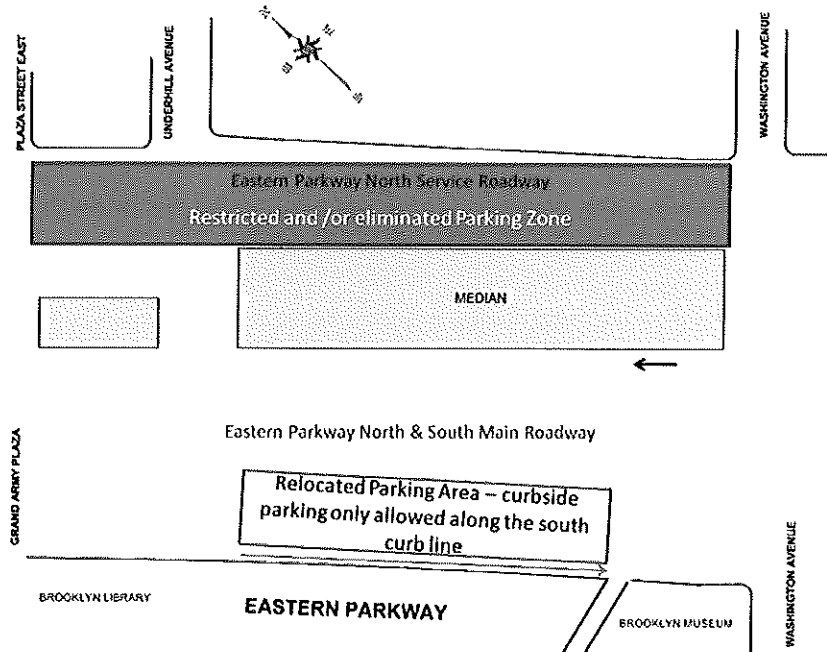
DURING NON-WORKING HOURS (INCLUDING WEEKENDS):

- Motorists will be able to enter the Eastern Parkway Service Road at Washington Avenue.

In the interim, curbside parking will be allowed:

- Along the Eastern Parkway Service Road from 41 Eastern Parkway to 95 Eastern Parkway.
 - Parking is restricted from 115 Eastern Parkway to 175 Eastern Parkway.
- Along the south curb line of the Eastern Parkway Main Roadway east of Underhill Avenue to the Brooklyn Museum driveway.

WHY IS THIS WORK BEING DONE?

These parking restrictions are to facilitate the installations of combined sewers and trunk water mains.

WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF WORK?

The contractor's typical working hours are Monday – Friday between the hours of 7:00AM–6:00PM.

COMMUNITY IMPACTS DURING COMBINED SEWER & TRUNK WATER MAIN INSTALLATIONS

The following are temporary impacts while the work is being performed:

- Parking will be restricted and/or eliminated in certain locations;
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
