

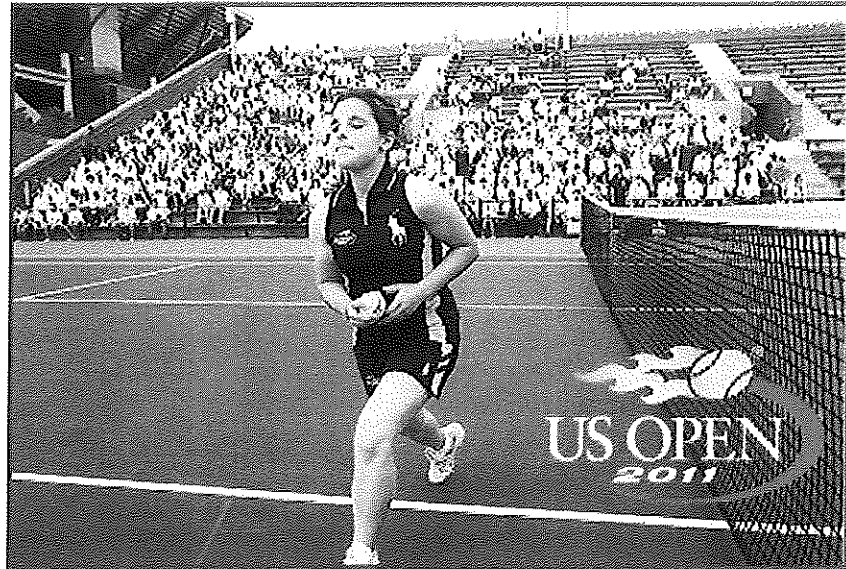

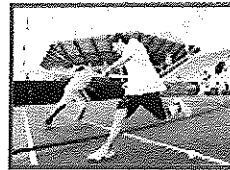

We're looking for energetic tennis fans ages 14 and over to be a vital part of the action at our Grand Slam event as an official US Open ballperson! Below you will find the important details concerning the tryout and what to expect if selected for duty at the 2011 US Open.

DETAILS:

Who: Ages 14 and older trying out for the coolest summer job in sports.

What: Approximately 80 sought-after positions as ballpersons for the 2011 US Open are up for grabs. Prospective ballpersons will be evaluated by US Open officials on their running, throwing and catching skills.

When: Thursday, June 23
Registration for General Public Tryouts begins at 3:00 p.m.

Evaluation process will begin at approximately 4:00 p.m., after a welcome by US Open Ballperson Director Tina Taps.

Additional information: US Open ballpersons are paid an hourly wage.
