PUBLIC SESSION:

- I. **Representatives from the American Heart Association** will inform the community about the organization's first ever **Brooklyn Start! Heart Walk**, to raise awareness about preventing heart disease and stroke through community building and fund-raising. It will take place on Sunday, October 11th 2009, in Prospect Park. The Start! Heart Walk is held in more than 400 communities nationwide.
- II. **Application submitted to the Department of Transportation by Legacy Van Lines** to operate a new commuter van authority (number of vans to be used 3) in Brooklyn, service area to include portions of Community District 9.
- III. **Consider ULURP Application #090323PQK**, submitted by the Administration for Children's Services and the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, pursuant to Section 197-c of the NYC Charter, for the acquisition of **Mosdoth Child Care Center, 420 Lefferts Avenue, Brooklyn**, between New York and Brooklyn Avenues, Block 1331 Lot 9, for continued use as a child care center.
- IV. **Consider Application N090412ZRY – FRESH Zoning for Neighborhood Grocery Stores** – a proposed amendment to the Zoning Resolution to promote the development of neighborhood grocery stores and supermarkets community districts identified as being in high need of additional fresh food retail. The FRESH program will combine a package of zoning and financial incentives for the development of grocery stores. Both the zoning and the financial incentives apply to Community District 9.
